THE REFLECTING POOL

Welcome to May, the month of Pentecost. Pentecost is the fiftieth day after Easter, and it refers to the coming of the Spirit shortly after the death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus. As loyal Episcopalians, we proclaim the words of the Nicene Creed every Sunday, saying: "We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets." We say these words so much that we do not often stop to think about them. What can we say about the Spirit?!

First, the Holy Spirit is the "giver of life". This is not in the sense that one flips a switch. Rather, it is a force, a power, that <u>animates</u> all living things. Yes, we need our carbohydrates, fats, and proteins, but they would go to waste if not for the Spirit that gives us purpose to do "the work we are given to do". It is a life force, and the reason there is <u>always</u> Spring. Second, the Spirit "proceeds" from the Father and Son. It proceeds not by any visible mechanism, but by spiration, or breathing, filling the air among us and around us with the unique inspiration that can only come from God. Yes, we breathe in the Spirit! In goes the good air, and out goes the bad. Finally, it has "spoken through the prophets". There have been many great and mighty prophets through the ages, but there are many times more "normal" ones. I am talking about us, for we are prophets, too.

Most of us have probably not experienced the Spirit via visible tongues of fire or by suddenly quoting scripture in multiple languages. No worries. When we are compelled by that "inner voice", those urges that cannot be denied, to do the work of the Body of Christ on Earth; the Spirit is indeed talking to us and through us. Sometimes we are simply grateful to be a part of God's ongoing creation. I hope your Spring is colorful, warm, and filled with the Spirit.


